### Activity Instructions

#### Before Reading

Look at the front cover. What do you think this story might be about?

What do you already know about heritage?

What questions do you have before we start reading?

#### During Reading

1. Who are the main characters? Describe them.
2. Where is the story set? (Bonwire village, Ashanti Region, Ghana)
3. What problem does the main character face?
4. How does the character feel at the beginning, middle, and end?
5. Find a word you don't know. Can you work out what it means from the context?

#### After Reading

1. What was your favourite part of the story? Why?
2. Would you recommend this book to a friend? Give reasons.
3. What did you learn about kente cloth?
4. If you could ask the author one question, what would it be?
5. Draw your favourite scene from the story.
